

This ergonomically designed KX-T7633 digital proprietary telephone offers a host of state-of-the-art functions to meet the needs of the demanding customer. A full set of control keys allow access to frequently-used functions such as transferring and conferencing calls. The new Navigator Pad provides speed and efficiency when programming names and telephone numbers, searching of quick-dial numbers and use of the many other system features.

#### ■ Multi-Angle Tilt Body

The body can be set to any of four angles to save space and allow for the most comfortable positioning. By changing the body tilt, you can also change the angle of the LCD display to obtain the optimum viewing angle for easy operation.

#### ☐ 3-Line, 24-Character Display with Back-Light

The LCD displays the various system information such as Caller ID, Date and Time, Call Log, Speed Dialing and Feature menus. The contrast level and back light settings are adjustable to adapt to different lighting conditions. The Multi-Language LCD Support allows the extension users to select from up to the five languages.

#### □ 24 Flexible Outside Line (CO) Keys

Each extension user can program these keys for various functions such as CO Line appearance, Direct Station Selection (DSS) Key, One-touch Dial or feature setting, all of which help you achieve smoother call handling. Each key has a dual colour LED (red/green) that shows information such as line status, extension status or whether a feature is on or off.

#### □ Optional 12-Button CO Key Module

The KX-T7636 can utilize a 12-button add-on module (KX-T7603) that will expand your current 24 flexible CO keys to 36.

#### □ Optional Built-in USB Port Module

The KX-T7636 is designed for use with an internal plug-in module so that the USB Module Card (KX-T7601) can be built right into your digital proprietary telephone. This USB interface simplifies operations with the use of the CTI solutions such as PC Phone and PC Console applications.

#### □ Extra Device Port (XDP) / Digital XDP (v1.1)

The XDP jack on the back of the phone can have the same extension number as the phone itself, for convenient use of an answering machine or a cordless phone. It could also be a different extension number so you can use a modem or fax on one phone line while speaking on another line. Using D-XDP (v1.1), you can connect a digital proprietary telephone for another extension user. With this feature it is possible to increase the number of digital sets without additional station cards.
